#### HISTORICAL NOTE—How can we forget:

While pondering how to respond to the consistent assault on family values, I did some research. I was reminded of Vice President Dan Quayle's 1992 speech in Los Angeles regarding the LA Riots. He spoke about the decay of moral values and family structure in American society as one of the reasons for the rioting.

In his speech Quayle also said, "it doesn't help matters when primetime TV has Murphy Brown—a character who supposedly epitomizes today's intelligent, highly paid, professional woman—mocking the importance of fathers, by bearing a child alone, and calling it just another 'lifestyle choice,'" referring to the television show *Murphy Brown*.

Quayle's speech was one of the most memorable incidents of the 1992 campaign ...and is one of those remarks that has led to the debate on family values in society today.
